

Please see below course requirements for Non-BBM students taking Finance as a Second Major:

For AY2019/2020 intake onwards

You must take:

- Finance (FNCE101)* / Finance for Law (FNCE103) **
- Corporate Finance (FNCE201)
- Corporate Reporting and Financial Analysis (ACCT201)
- Financial Markets and Investments (FNCE102) ([This course replaces the old FNCE102 FIIM](#))
- 3 other Finance electives

*FNCE101 has co-requisites of Introductory Statistics (COR-STAT1202) or Introduction to Statistical Theory (COR-STAT 1203) and Financial Accounting (ACCT101/ACCT111) or Financial Accounting for Law (ACCT105).

**Please note that ONLY LLB students can choose to take FNCE 101 Finance or FNCE 103 Finance for Law.

Additional requirements:

Any 1 CU from the following:

- Financial Accounting (ACCT101)/ Financial Accounting for Law (ACCT105)***
- Marketing (MKTG101)
- Management Communication (COR-COMM 1304)
- Management of People at Work (OBHR101)
- Operations Management (OPIM201)
- Strategy (MGMT102)

***For LLB students who take FNCE103 Finance for Law instead of FNCE 101 Finance, they will have to take ACCT 101/ACCT 111 Financial Accounting or ACCT 105 Financial Accounting for Law.

For all other non-BBM students, they should take ACCT 101/ ACCT111 Financial Accounting as this is a pre-requisite for Corporate Reporting and Financial Analysis (ACCT201).

For intakes before AY2019/2020

You must take:

- Finance (FNCE101) * / Finance for Law (FNCE103) **
- Corporate Finance (FNCE201)
- Corporate Reporting and Financial Analysis (ACCT201)
- Financial Markets and Investments (FNCE102) ([This course was known as Financial Instruments, Institutions, and Markets before AY19/20. Students who have taken FIIM do not need to take FMI](#))
- 3 other Finance electives
