



Singapore Management University's Finance Group in the Lee Kong Chian School of Business seeks applications for Practice-track faculty positions at the Associate and Full professor level. Applicants should have strong industry experience in business and finance, excellent teaching, strong research interests, and commitment to collegial service. Preference will be given to those with a Ph.D. in finance and economics. Practice-track professors are expected to teach finance and finance-related courses in undergraduate and postgraduate programmes. They are also expected to be involved in course development and outreach to the industries, and work closely with the Sim Kee Boon Institute for Financial Economics (SKBI).

The preferred start date is July 2017 or sooner. Working conditions and compensation are competitive with major universities.

SMU subscribes to all major financial databases and provides generous research funds to support conference travel and other research activities. The group hosts an annual summer research camp; a very active research seminar series; and visits by distinguished finance scholars from leading research universities. The Finance group also has a Ph.D. program with high quality students and good recent placements.
