He holds a PhD in Technology Entrepreneurship and Strategic Management from the Michael G. Foster School of Business at the University of Washington, Seattle. Prior to joining LKCSB, he was a faculty member at Nanyang Business School and prior to that he had worked for more than seven years across various functions in multiple industries, including start-ups. David has completed Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) examinations. His research centers on strategy, entrepreneurship, and organizations. His research aims to address major challenges that confront society and the world in the foreseeable future: the sustainability and creation of opportunities through corporate governance and entrepreneurship. For example, to make timely and meaningful contributions through research, his research examines the aftermath of the Global Recession of 2008, other corporate scandals, and the reputational sustainability in start-up community.
